

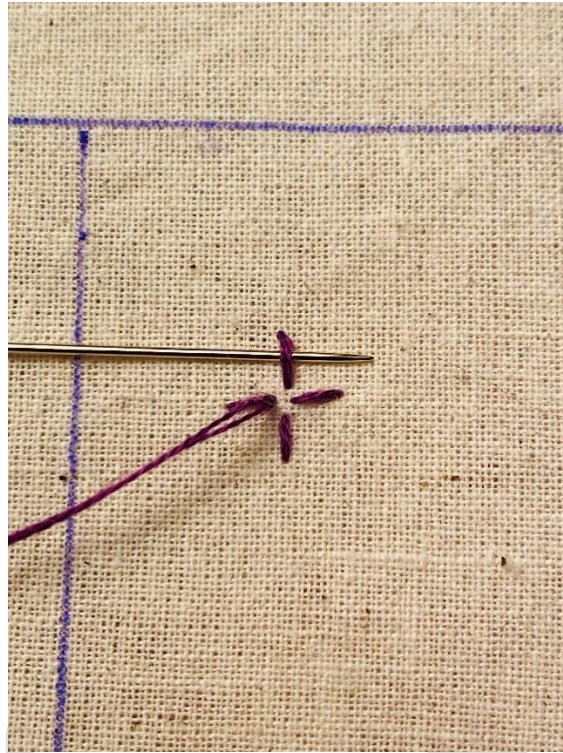
Woven Circle Stitch



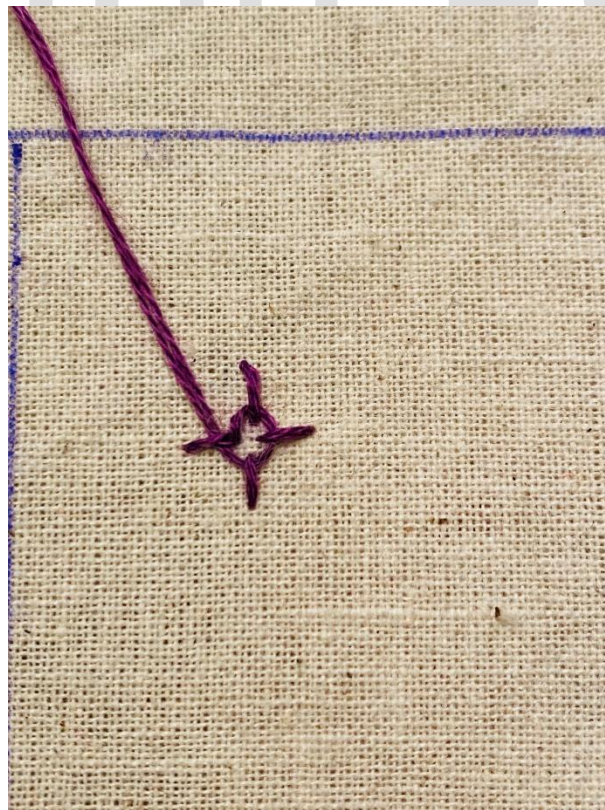
Start by stitching four straight stitches in a cross shape (North, South, East and West) leaving a space where the four stitches meet.

Come up at the inside of the 'West' stitch





Bring the needle under the 'North' stitch from left to right
Carry on round the circle, bringing the needle under each of your straight stitches.



Carry on in this fashion, until you've done as many loops as you would like to do.



When you've finished, bring the needle to the back of the fabric just underneath your last round row – hiding the end.



Play around with this stitch, experimenting with the length of the initial straight stitches, and the number of 'rounds' that you do.
You may want to play with colours, and perhaps different thicknesses of thread.
