

## Sword Stitch



The sword stitch is a simple stitch, but very satisfying.

Start by stitching a straight stitch at a diagonal from bottom left to top right.

Come back up to the top of the fabric to the bottom right of the top of the stitch (which gives you a sort of a triangle shape).

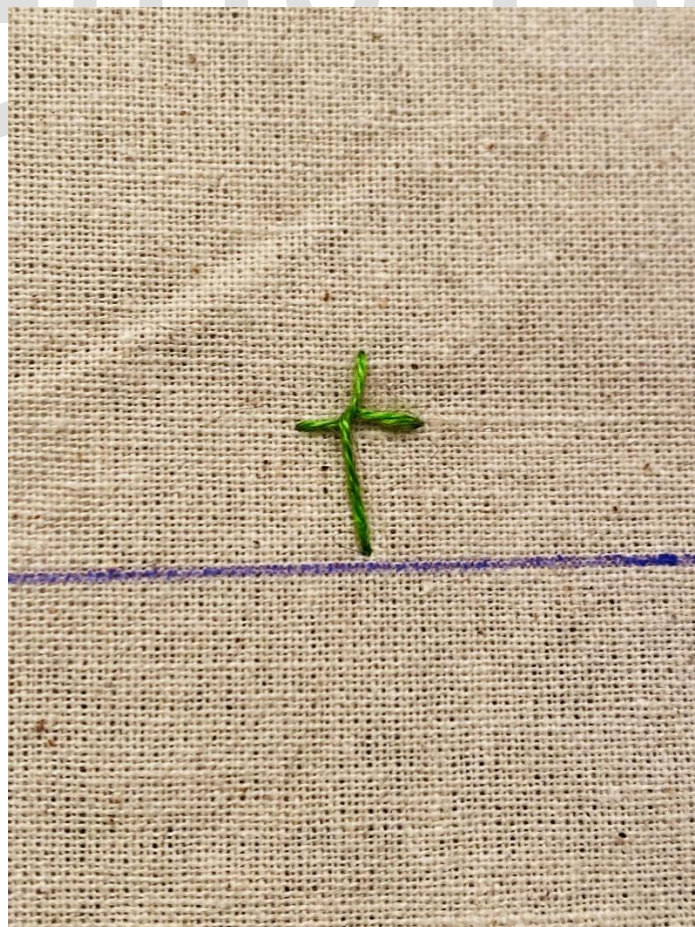
However, before you pull your needle all the way through, push your needle underneath the straight stitch you've just completed.



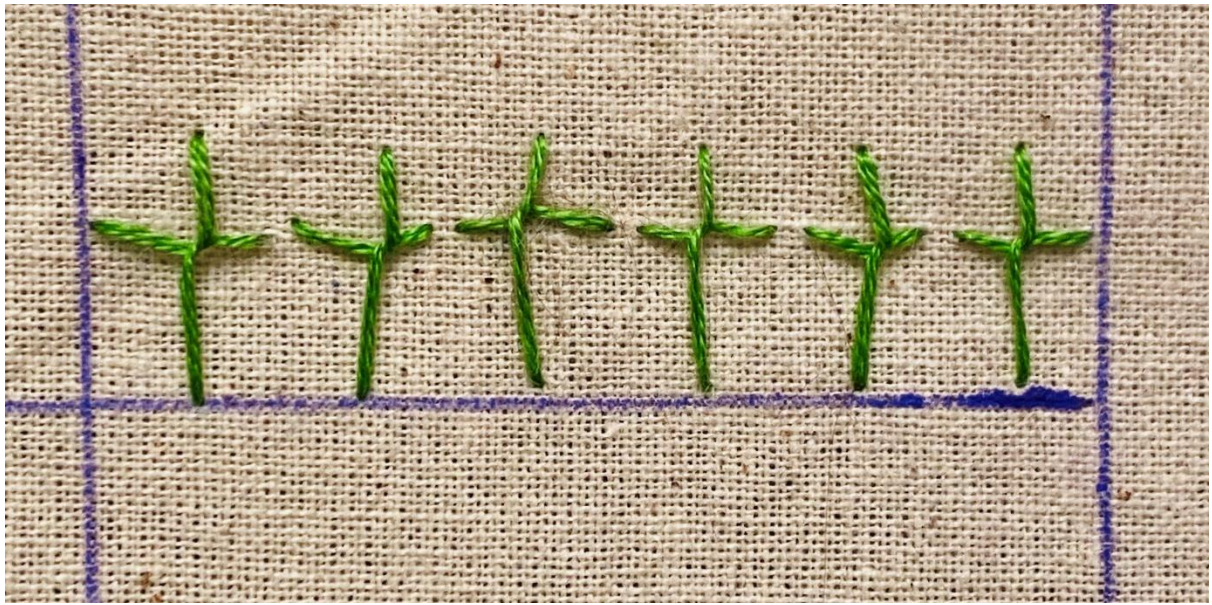




To complete the sword shape, you want to go back down, directly underneath the top of the stitch, but further down – the 'blade' of the sword stitch.







Practice this stitch a few times, trying to keep the stitches even.

Then play with different sizes and dimensions
