

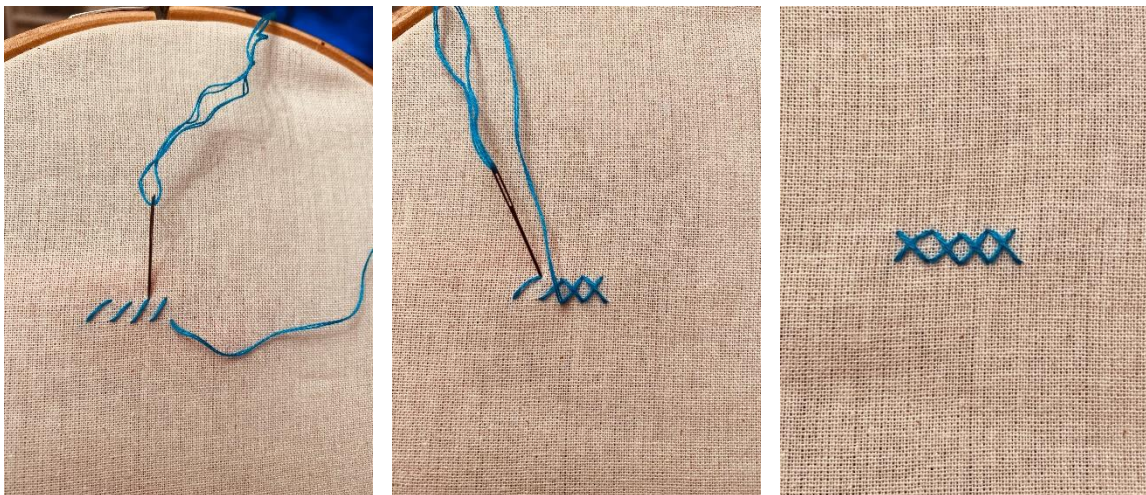
Cross Stitch

Cross stitches are made up of two single stitches crossed over the middle. You can either create a row of cross stitches, or a single cross stitch at a time.

Create a diagonal stitch from the bottom left to the top right. Continue to make a series of similar stitches.



At the end of the row, come back up through the fabric directly underneath the last stitch, and continue back along the row, making diagonal stitches in the opposite direction.



Alternatives are to make each stitch individually (rather than in a row) – or making the first row from top left to bottom right (or vice versa)
