

Pueblo Stitch



The Pueblo stitch uses two colours – thread your needle with two strands each of orange and green (in this example – you can choose your own colours). Knot the end.

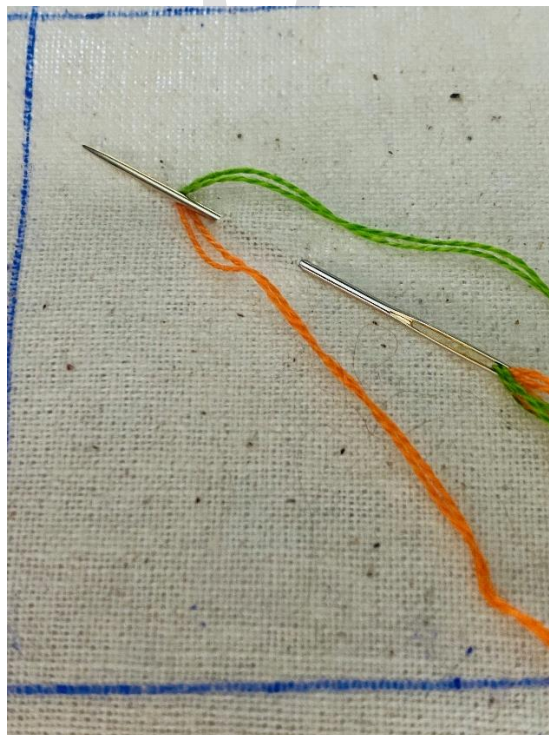


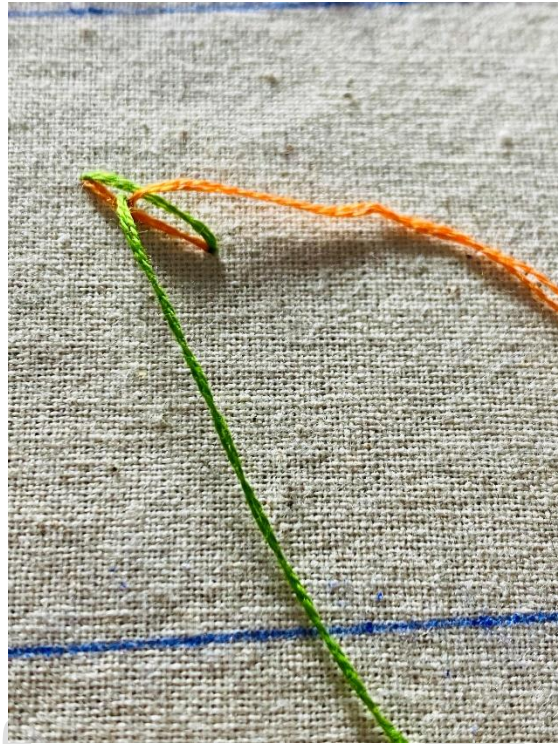


Separate out the orange and green.

Bring your needle down and up through the fabric (as in the picture below) inbetween the two colours.

Pull the needle through.





Swap the colours over, so that your green is now one the left where you had orange before, and vice versa.

Do another stitch as above (down and up through the two colours)

Be careful about where you place your needle – it needs to come up in the middle of the previous stitch.





Carry on in this vein, swapping colours over to alternate them, and stitch a line of pueblo stitches.

Carry on to create any pattern that you would like to – in this example we stitch an arrow:
